## Terms and Conditions

### Conditions for subsidised programme fees

- To qualify for the programme, parents or guardians must already be registered under the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS), and provide the relevant documents as proof.
- Students must attend at **least 80% of the programme**. The student may be withdrawn from the programme at our discretion should the student's attendance fall below the 80% mark without a valid reason.
- If the student is unable to attend any of the classes, the parent or guardian (as may be applicable) shall call us at **67770041** or email us at **info@wishingwell.org.sg** in advance citing the reason(s) for the absence.
- **Students must attend at least 5 Learning Journeys and 5 Life Skills classes of their choice during the year.**
- **If the students sign up for, but fail to attend more than 2 of the above events without valid reason, the student may be suspended from the programme.**

### Conditions for withdrawal after commencement of programme

- A minimum of one month's notice (provided to us at the telephone number or email address stated above) is required from the parent or guardian (as may be applicable) for withdrawal of the student from the programme.

### Indemnity and Insurance

- Parents and guardians are responsible for declaring all illnesses, medical conditions and/or physical disabilities of the student in this Registration Form.
- While all reasonably practicable precautions are taken to ensure the safety of the students, by signing this Registration Form, the parent(s) or guardian(s) (as may be applicable) of the student enrolled in the programme in connection with this Registration Form hereby irrevocably and unconditionally agree and undertake to Children's Wishing Well (CWW) that CWW and/or any of its administrators, directors, employees, servants, agents or volunteers shall not be held liable for any and all loss, damages, expenses, accidents and/or injuries (including death) that may be directly or indirectly incurred or suffered by the student (and/or his or her parent(s) or guardian(s)) during the programme, whether on the premises of CWW or at an external venue, and will hold harmless and fully indemnify CWW and and/or any of its administrators, directors, employees, servants, agents or volunteers against such liability.
